

Town Beach Rules and Regulations

- 1. Swimming allowed in designated areas only. Public swimmers must not interfere with swim lesson sessions.
- 2. No alcoholic beverages will be possessed or consumed on any public beach, and no person shall be intoxicated.
- 3. No person shall commit any obscene or indecent act or use profane/obscene language.
- 4. Carry in/Carry out policy No littering, all refuse brought in must be brought out. No glass containers will be allowed on beaches. No household refuse allowed in rubbish containers.
- 5. No person shall damage, deface, or remove any building, structure or sign belonging to the Town of Lunenburg.
- 6. No selling, advertising, or giving away of goods and services will be permitted except by concessionaires under contract with the Town or by written permission from the Recreation Department and Park Commission.
- 7. No fires, charcoal or gas grills are allowed.
- 8. No animals or pets are permitted on any area of the beach, with the exception of service animals.
- 9. No person shall disturb the peace and tranquility of others.
- 10. Children (15) years of age or younger must be accompanied by a parent or person 18 years of age or older responsible for his or her behavior within the beach area.
- 11. Ball playing, kite flying and Frisbee playing are permitted at the discretion of the Lifeguards only.
- 12. Scuba diving, skin diving, and all other methods of underwater swimming are prohibited in designated swimming areas.
- 13. Sailboats, canoes, kayaks, windsurfers, surfboards etc. are prohibited in all swimming areas.
- 14. Beach umbrellas are permitted at the discretion of the Lifeguards/Beach Director only.
- 15. Fishing is not permitted in designated swim areas.
- 16. The use of drones is prohibited on the beach.
- 17. Approved like vests and lifejackets are allowed. Lifejackets are available for non-swimmers and at-risk swimmers.
- 18. Use of rafts, tubes, inflatables and other similar types of flotation devices are prohibited, including water wings, and suits with foam inserts.
- 19. Closures: The Town of Lunenburg reserves the right to close areas to swimming for health and safety reasons.
- 20. Hours: Unless otherwise authorized, the beach is closed to the general public during these hours— 6:00 p.m. to 12 noon Saturday & Sunday, 7:00p.m. to 10:00a.m. Monday Friday.
- 21. Park and beach officials and lifeguards must be obeyed in the enforcement of the above regulations and in any other situation in which the judgement of the lifeguard must be exercised for the protection and safety of persons using the beach facilities.
- 22. Masks must be worn entering and exiting the facility.
- 23. Social distancing guidelines must be followed, including 12ft distance between toweling areas.
- 24. Beach capacity will be limited to 70 per time frame.
- 25. Pre-registration/reservation is required, no walk-ins accepted at this time.
- 26. Beach house is NOT to be open for entry and exit, ONLY for restroom access.
- 27. Check in/Check out will be conducted at the gate or porch of the beach house.
