To view and register for programs, please visit www.LunenburgRecreation.com

Lunenburg Recreation Department programs are open to both residents and non residents, unless otherwise noted. Our programs are supported solely by participant fees and residents have priority registration periods. Registration is first come, first served; Lunenburg residents have priority through advanced enrollment periods.

Online Registration is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED at LunenburgRecreation.com and **is the PREFERRED METHOD**. We accept **Walk-in Registration**, by appointment only; please e-mail Kwright@lunenburgonline.com to set up an appointment. We accept **Cash, Check, & Credit Card** - Visa or MasterCard only. Creating an online account prior to registration is encouraged.

PLEASE NOTE: Registration for all programs ends the Thursday before the program start date, unless otherwise noted.

GENERAL INFORMATION

REFUNDS AND WITHDRAWALS

Refund are only available if a class is cancelled or if there is a medical reason. A refund will be issued if a participant is unable to attend a class due to an unexpected prolonged illness or injury. This request must be made prior to the end of the program session and may require a doctor's note. Medical refunds may be prorated for classes missed. Classes missed due to common illness or schedule conflicts cannot be refunded.

LOW ENROLLMENT

The minimum number needed to run a class is listed with the program description. Classes with low enrollment will be notified that the class is in danger of being cancelled one week prior to the class starting (when time allows). The actual class will be cancelled 48 hours prior to the scheduled start dates and a refund will be issued if the minimum isn't met. The Recreation Department reserves the right to reschedule, postpone, combine or change classes. You will be notified via e-mail if your class is cancelled.

CLASS REMINDERS

The Recreation Department may send out e-mail blasts for a variety of reasons, highlighting several programs, a specific program, registration information or general information. The Recreation Department does not send out individual program reminders to participants that are registered. Once you register for a program, you will receive a confirmation via an e-mail receipt. Refunds cannot be given for missed classes/programs due to not receiving a reminder.

MAKE UP CLASSES

All attempts will be made to reschedule classes that have been cancelled due to inclement weather, instructor absence, or other unforeseen circumstances. Typically a program that meets weekly will extend another week at the same day and time. Check with the Instructor to confirm. Classes missed due to participant absence because of scheduling conflicts or personal reasons cannot be made up.

DROP OFF PROGRAMS

Parents/Guardians of children under 10 years of age participating in our programs are required to accompany their children to and from the location of the program (i.e. classrooms, gymnasium, etc.) and must remain on the premises should they be needed. Should a parent or guardian leave the area of the program, they MUST inform the instructor where they can be found, including contact information. This procedure has been established for the protection and safety of all children within Recreation programs.

PHOTO/VIDEO POLICY

The Recreation Department may make, have, use, publish and reproduce photographs and/or video of participants for its record, public relation purposes, recognition, and/or other projects related to the wholesome promotion of tis programs unless permission is denied in writing.

FINANCIAL AID

Some programs may be able to offer financial assistance or scholarship to qualifying applicants. In many cases, the most recent tax form, and other supporting documentation is required. Contact us for more information.

RESIDENTS/NON-RESIDENTS

Programs are open to residents and non-residents, unless otherwise noted. Registration is first come first serve, Lunenburg residents have priority registration for some programs.

AGE POLICY

Children must meet the age requirement for a program by the FIRST DAY of a class. Children must be toilet trained to attend programs unaccompanied by an adult.

CALENDAR

Calendars found in the back of the brochure list the start date of all programs as well as holiday hours, closings, community events, and other important event date information.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

All classes (day and evening) will be cancelled when Lunenburg Public Schools are closed. If Lunenburg Public Schools have a delayed opening, All Recreation Department programs will start at their regular time, unless otherwise noted. In the event we need to cancel evening, weekend or summer programs, it will be listed on our website and an e-mail blast will be sent out.
